of operation being April 26, 2015. A couple late storms extended the season a few weeks although it wasn't the winter we were all hoping for. To that extent, California is in a serious drought with water conservation at a premium. During your next stay with us, please be mindful and conserve water whenever possible. Prohibited uses for water include:

- Use of potable water on outdoor landscapes during and within 48 hours after measureable snow and/or rainfall.
- Serving drinking water other than upon request in eating or drinking establishments.
- Each guest is provided the option of choosing not to have towels and linens laundered daily.
- Washing of sidewalks, driveways and other hard surfaces.
- Excessive irrigation run-off.
- Excessive plumbing leaks not repaired.
- Non-commercial washing of privately owned vehicles, RV's, trailer, bikes and boats except from a bucket and with a hose fitted with a shut-off nozzle.

Exciting Updates

We are pleased to announce that an upgrade to the WiFi is in the works! AT&T has run power from our electric room to a new dedicated circuit where the fiber 20Mb/s line will come into the building. The new service will increase the Internet speed by 20 times!

The remainder of the new carpet project was completed the week of May 10. To date, every room has new carpet along with a thicker pad and underlayment to help reduce the noise from above. In addition to the room carpet, the third floor hallway along with both stairwells has been completed. The final areas completed include the first and second floor hallways, the clubhouse and the front and back office.
